

The British Section aims to inspire an understanding of British culture and educational values through teaching, pastoral care and extra-curricular activities. The British Section sets out to offer its distinctive education to children from English-speaking and bilingual family backgrounds, and to those who have learned English as a second or foreign language and who are committed to developing it at mother-tongue level.

The bi-lingual and bi-cultural curriculum (*double-enseignement*) requires commitment to both the British Section and the French education system. It is a challenging educational pathway that demands considerable academic ability and intellectual flexibility as well as motivation, engagement and resilience. Given these demands, the British Section assesses all pupils who apply.

THE BRITISH SECTION AT A GLANCE



The British Section is a fee-paying section offering mother-tongue English curriculum to children aged 11 to 18. Pupils spend between 6-9 hours per week (depending on the year group) learning in English with British Section teachers, and the rest of their lesson time in a French class learning all other subjects in French, within the context of the French state school system and hence a primarily francophone educational environment. Consequently, British Section pupils receive a genuine bilingual and bicultural education.
