**Health protocol: what are the specificities of the new school year ?**

### **Will there be an Open House?**

No, because groups are not allowed and access to the school for parents is still forbidden.

### **Will parents be able to access the school?**

No, except by appointment confirmed by the management or in case of emergency, upon presentation of the Health Kit and according to the control procedure at the entrance and upon accompaniment by the guards to enter and leave.

A specific area is set up outside the school. The distance must be respected in this waiting area.

### **Is wearing a mask mandatory?**

Mandatory to enter the school except for kindergarten students.

Mandatory in all indoor communal areas (except for sports activities and kindergarten students)

Optional in outdoor spaces, provided that the distance of one meter between people is respected.

### **Do the masks have to be provided by the parents?**

Yes, and provide an extra spare mask.

### **Will there be a distance learning facility for students outside China who cannot attend the premises?**

The teachers will have to give their full attention to the students present in the classes and provide them with the best possible reception and follow-up conditions. A distance learning system cannot be envisaged in these circumstances. Enrolment will be effective on the date of entry into the classroom (except in specific cases or in secondary school for those who wish to be enrolled from the start of the school year and have access to Pronote).

### **Will there be back-to-school meetings as usual?**

No face-to-face parent meetings on premises. They will take place via Teams.

### **Will there be a specific meeting for allophone parents?**

This meeting is not authorized but all the documents are on the website.

### **When will the ACS start?**

The ACS service will only start once the school organization has stabilized at 100%, at best after the National Holiday vacations on October 12th.

### **Will a psychological unit be set up?**

Yes, by the school psychologist. Contact Mrs Cassier by telephone (13911010032) or email ([psychologue@lfip.net.cn](mailto:psychologue@lfip.net.cn)). She will be able to refer your child to Mrs Galley, clinical psychologist, who will be on duty during the first 15 days of the new school year.

### **Will hydroalcoholic gel be made available in the facility?**

Hydroalcoholic gel is available in every classroom, in the corridors, at the restaurant and on the buses.

### **Will there be water fountains available to students?**

Yes, they are allowed. A specific disinfection process is in place.

### **How will the school canteen work?**

Timetables, passage modalities and layout will be arranged to allow for the respect of protocol and distances. The children will eat in class groups.

The snack service usually offered to pupils from 4th to 12th grade must be discontinued.

The self-service Salad Bar can no longer be offered. Entrance tickets will be distributed on the tray.

As it is forbidden to go to the snack bar at the end of the service, the children must ask for the appropriate quantities at the first visit to the distribution line.

### **How do you get on the bus?**

Wearing a mask is compulsory for everyone (except for kindergarten students)

Strict verification of the requested documents in printed form when boarding the bus.

- Temperature declaration over 14 days (on the day of school only)
- DAILY Health Declaration - Must be submitted daily.

Without this (these) document(s), access to the bus will be denied.

### **How are the sports classes going?**

No mask is required. The activities can be adapted by the teachers.

### **Is a temperature check carried out at school?**

On arrival at the school, systematically

And at midday, when you go to the refectory.

### **What happens if the temperature exceeds 37.3°?**

If the temperature is 37.3°C or higher, the student is then taken to the isolation room near the infirmary. The nurse equipped accordingly checks the temperature again and based on this takes the necessary measures for the return home or for transfer to the authorized hospital. If this student comes from a bus, all students and bus staff are gathered in a separate area from the other students. The Chinese and French authorities are informed.

During a class or at break:

The teacher calls the nurse, the student stays where he is and the nurse protected by safety equipment comes to pick him up and take him to the containment room adjacent to the infirmary. The nurse consults a Chinese referring doctor by phone who, based on the description of the symptoms, decides whether or not to hospitalize the student.

The other students in the class immediately put on the N95 mask and all adult persons in contact with the student concerned remain confined in another classroom wearing the N95 mask until the test result is communicated. All parents are immediately and regularly informed by the school life service and the deputy principal. In case of a negative test, each person goes home, in case of a positive test, everyone is required to follow the instructions of the Chinese authorities.

## Are there any specific documents to be provided?

A daily declaration of health must be submitted :

- For students taking the bus, when boarding the bus. Access will be refused in the absence of this document.
- For students entering directly, at the entrance of the school. Access to the school will be refused if this document is not presented.

A declaration of temperature for the 14 days on the day of the beginning of the school year.

## What should I do if my child has a mild fever, or coughs or vomits in the morning before going to school?

You must keep your child at home and inform the infirmary by e-mail ([infirmerie@lfip.net.cn](mailto:infirmerie@lfip.net.cn)) before the start of classes, as well as the school life for the secondary school ([viescolaire@lfip.net.cn](mailto:viescolaire@lfip.net.cn)) or the secretary's office for the primary school ([secretariatc@lfip.net.cn](mailto:secretariatc@lfip.net.cn)) before the start of classes.

## What should I do when I return from quarantine on a delayed arrival?

As soon as you arrive in China, at the beginning of your quarantine, please inform the school secretary's office ([secretariata@lfip.net.cn](mailto:secretariata@lfip.net.cn)). Change place and time of day on the parents' portal Eduka

## If we leave Beijing to travel in China, is there a specific approach?

It is strongly recommended by the Chinese authorities not to move during the 14 days before the return. **For any travel, you must inform the school** (enter the place of travel on the parents' portal).

- Return following a trip to a high-risk zone:
  - no access to the school authorized
- Returning from a medium risk area: access to the facility if the following conditions are met :
  - 14 days of medical observation at home or at the hotel
  - Obligation to obtain an access code for the Green Health application
  - Negative nucleic acid test within 7 days prior to return to the facility.
- Return from a low-risk area :
  - Requirement to obtain a Green Health Application Access Code
