Position : Literature teacher for the secondary school (Year 7 to 13)

Subject : Literature in English

Job profile:

- Teaching literature lessons in English for middle school and high school.
- Full time contract of 18 hours a week (Literature classes + extra ESL classes if needed), CDD

Conduct English language and English Literature lessons for middle school and high school in British international sections with a Cambridge-based program (SI, IGCSE)

On top of teaching hours, the candidate will also build their syllabus, prepare lessons, and grade papers.

The candidate will attend teachers' meetings, end-of-term meetings, parent-teacher meetings as well as International Section meetings.

The candidate will take an active part in promoting the International Section.

The candidate will facilitate partnerships with British institutions in Beijing, and with International Sections abroad or in France.

The candidate will engage in teamwork with the teaching community and participate in school projects.

The candidate will adapt their teaching to the diversity of students by providing each of them with the necessary support and assessing their achievements.

Candidate requirements:

- English native speaker
- Experience in teaching literature in the British curriculum (secondary school)
- Knowledge of the OIB (Option Internationale du Baccalauréat)
- Knowledge of the new BFI curriculum (Baccalauréat Français International)
- Experience in implementing methods of assessment of student progress, as well as communicating them to the students in a clear manner.
- Building a coherent syllabus and scheme of work for each class.
- Offering a diversity of activities.
- Establishing a positive work environment.

- Ability to integrate technology to the curriculum.
- Being comfortable with teamwork.
- Adaptability
- A good command of the French language is a plus.

Qualifications:

- Recognized teaching qualification (PGCE, MASTER'S DEGREE)
- Having a master's degree together with a two-year experience in the UK or in an International Section (AEFE or French school)
- Terms and conditions:
- The candidate will be employed directly by the Lycée and will work under the authority of the headmaster.
- Remuneration will be based on school's salary scale
